The discussion shall lead to the identification of (at least) a single area or two areas of focus and the first definition of expected deliverables and related timeframes, on the basis of proposals and comments already presented by members of the SC during the past months, as feedback requested by the Chairman.

5. **Trends Analysis – Survey Methodology** [Discussion]

The aim of the discussion is to define the scope, the merits and the limitations of the survey of trends in Civil Engineering (Phase 1 presented during the 57th GA), with a view to the second phase of the survey.

The discussion should lead to a concrete road-map for the survey strategy.
