

HALF DAY EXCURSION TO STON (28th OCTOBER 2012)

10:00 Departure from hotel
(by minivan or bus with English speaking guide)

- Drive along Dubrovnik Riviera to Ston
- Walking tour of Ston, *famous because of it's city walls and salt pans*
- Sea food and fish lunch served in the famous Bota Sare restaurant

17:00 Return to hotel



Ston is the main town of the county which is located on the Peljesac peninsula. The town of Ston has the second largest wall surrounding it – this defense wall dates back to 14th Century, it is 5,5 km and are protected by some 40 towers and 5 forts, the strongest being Bartolomija at the highest point, named for the saint-protector of arms. Diverging walls encompass Mali Ston on the north with the tower of Koruna, consisting of four smaller towers resembling a crown, from which it gets its name ('kruna'=crown). It is also the longest remaining fortification system in the world after the Chinese Wall. Ston also has the oldest salt pans in the Europe located on the sea. Ston is famous for it's oysters, coming from it's own breeding site.
