- The grant recipients can also greatly benefit the companies that offer an internship in many ways.
- They are excellently trained engineers/economists with university/technical college degrees.
- So far more than 20 German companies have recognised the opportunities that such grant recipients can offer them.
- A grant recipient costs approx. 15,000 20,000 €/year.

Skills and motivation





- Along with their native language, they speak German, are more or less fluent in English and sometimes also speak a further European language, e.g. Spanish or French.
- They are all highly motivated and they are able to apply their knowledge and skills in the company that offers them an internship although they do need some time before they are able to express themselves in German and completely understand German.
- In most cases they are also able to help the company that offers them an internship gain access to the market in their home country.

Requirements



Must speak German well enough that they can manage in Germany without an interpreter.

<u>Must</u> have concluded their studies with at least satisfactory results.









Application



Requirement for application:

The project or engineering work must

- involve our vital resources energy and/or water or waste water
- include cooperation between Germany and at least one neighbouring country
- have clear practical relevance or have reliably proved itself in practice or represent an outstanding theoretical approach.
