



31.05.2018 Sightseeing tour to Lahemaa National park.

Located on the northern coast of Estonia, Lahemaa is perfect for a hiking trip and nature watching. Here you will find stony and sandy seashores, picturesque bogs, pine and cliff forests, rivers that cut into the limestone cliff as well as erratic rocks left over from the last Ice Age.

Beginnig of the tour at 9.30. in the hotel lobby. Drive to Lahemaa National park. Short walk at Käsnu peninsula. Käsnu's nature enchants us with its beautiful forests, Estonia's biggest area of scattered boulders and naturally beautiful seaside.

Further we visit two Baltic German manors at Lahemaa national park.

Palmse Manor is one of the grandest baroque mansions in Estonia. The mansion and open-air museum were the first fully restored manor complex in the country. They are surrounded by the beautiful natural environment of Lahemaa National Park and provide an overview of Estonian manor life and architecture throughout the ages.

Sagadi manor: The history of the manor dates back for 500 years. For the time being Sagadi has become the center of tourism and natural and cultural education. The complex is extraordinary for its unity: lots of outbuildings with repaired roads, parkways, park and ponds.

Lunch at Sagadi manor.

Back in Tallinn at 16.00 the latest.

The tour includes some walking, so we advise you to have comfortable shoes.
