



2.06.2018 Tallinn panorama tour and Seaplane Harbour museum.

Guide will meet you at the hotel lobby at 13.10

Short panoramic tour by bus around the city wall of Old Tallinn. Stop at Toompea viewing platforms. Song Festival Arena.

End of bus tour at Seaplane Harbour. Tour continues in Seaplane Harbour.

The Seaplane Harbour, including the Seaplane Hangar, was built to become part of Peter the Great's naval fortress 100 years ago on orders from the Russian emperor Nicholas II. The architecture of the Hangar is remarkable, featuring the world's first columnless thin-shell concrete domes of such volume. The building was used for seaplanes until the Second World War!

Now it is one of Europe's grandest maritime museums. You are invited to see the authentic submarine Lembit from the 1930s, the century-old steam-powered icebreaker Suur Tõll, a Short 184 seaplane, mines, cannons and many other life-sized exhibits.

After the tour the bus takes you back to the hotel by 17.00 the latest.
