**Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)
for creation of
INESCO
International Network of Civil Engineers on Safety Construction**

Lisbon, 25th September 2019


World Council of Civil Engineering (WCCE) and European Council of Civil Engineers (ECCE) agree to create an International Network of Civil Engineers on Safety Construction, a non-profit network and with an ethical code and disciplinary system beyond his constituents organization, that aims to:

- Certify and register as Competent Person INESCO in Safety Construction the Civil Engineers.
- Contribute for the knowledge of the Safety Construction for Standards and Guidelines for the elaboration of Technical Reports of these issues.
- Position the INESCO as a relevant contributor in matters that are of interest to the network and civil engineers, namely: information on Safety Work on Construction.
- Promote the best characterization and definition of Safety Construction Work and claim for a uniformly characterization of Safety Construction Work in the world.
- To achieve a critical mass of professionals dedicated to promoting Safety Works on Construction.
- Maintain the best relations with the National Organizations and equivalent Professional Organizations, and especially with those represented by WCCE and ECCE.
- Promote Continuous Training and Professional Development among registered members, with maintenance by registered members of a record of their professional development activities and achievements which may include formal and informal training, attendance and presentations at relevant conferences, publication of articles and scientific papers, and other such activities which contribute to their professional standing.

The statutes will be developed within 6 months by a committee composed by one representative of WCCE and one representative of ECCE, and supported by the Ordem dos Engenheiros of Portugal, and should be presented for adjustments and approvals in each of the following WCCE and ECCE General Assemblies for joint signature in any of the General Assemblies that will occur in 2020.
