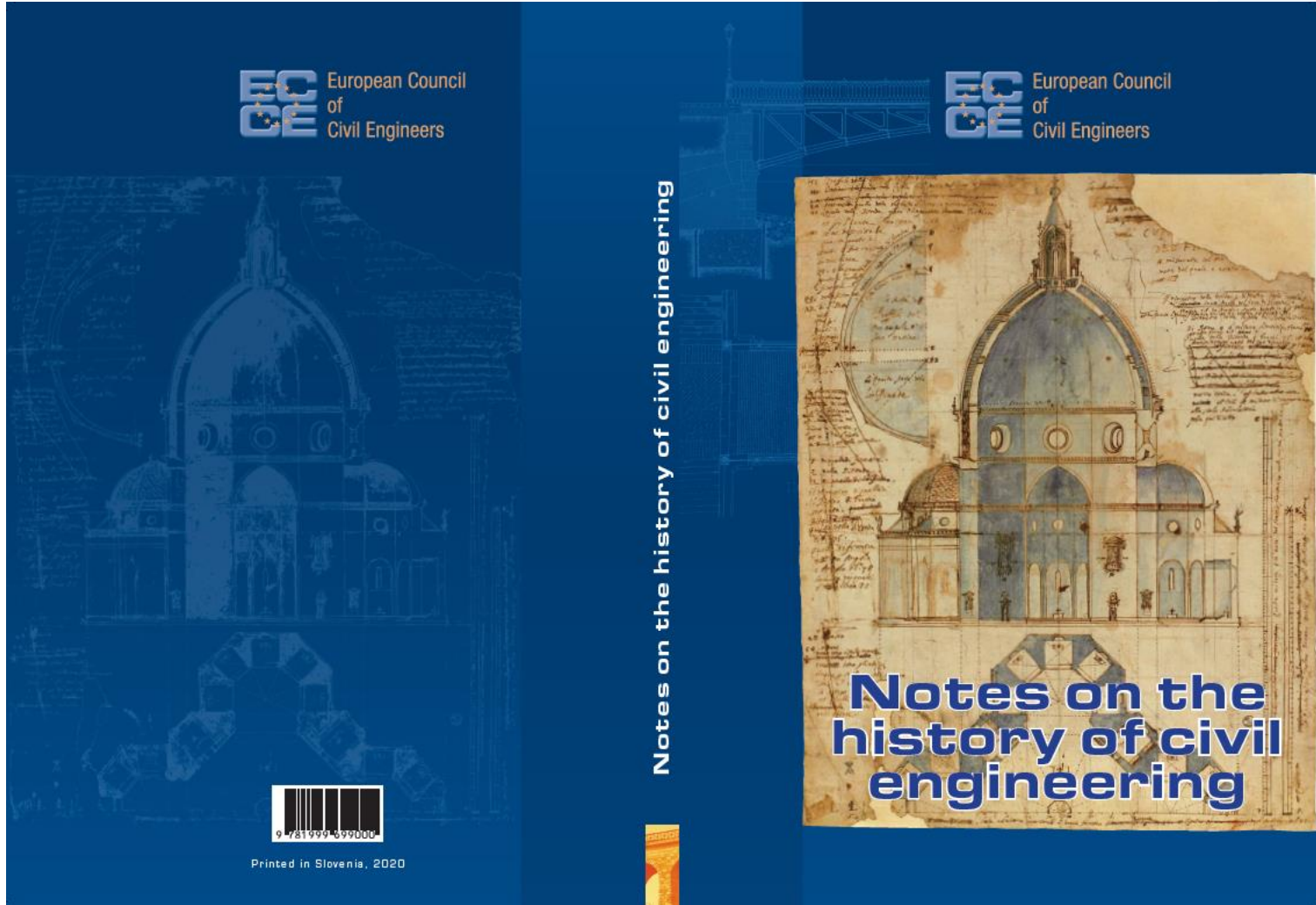

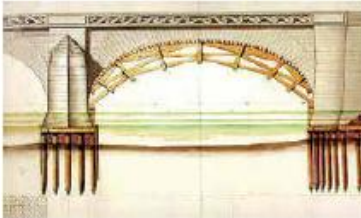

- During the 69<sup>th</sup> ECCE General Meeting that was held in Podgorica, Montenegro, ECCE President presented his ambition to produce a series of books on the history of civil engineering that will include contributions from the ECCE members and will showcase the national civil engineering history of each country.
- ECCE members have been requested to prepare their contributions for the 2<sup>nd</sup> volume of the book “Notes on the history of civil engineering”.
- Contributions are collected from Greece, Spain, U.K., Malta, France and Turkey.
- Currently, the materials that have been collected are under elaboration by Mr. Gorazd Humar who acts as editor-in-chief. Once the materials are assessed the preparation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> volume will start.
- The number of copies to be printed has not been determined yet.
- There is a provision of 5.000 EUR in the ECCE budget for 2021 for the preparation and printing of the 2<sup>nd</sup> volume of the book.
